Student Accommodation Easter Revision 2026

For the duration of the Easter Revision program (29 March – 17 April), Corpus Christi College will be welcoming students to their accommodation.

This Cambridge University college was founded in 1352. It is the 6th oldest college, and it is also the 2nd smallest one. It is the only college in Oxbridge that was founded by townspeople and not royalty or nobility. Its purpose was to train priests after the Black Death.

Corpus Christi has traditional, single bedrooms with free Wi-Fi access. Bed linen and towels are provided. We believe students will find the comfortable rooms and the atmosphere at Corpus Christi College conducive to study. All lessons will take place at MPW sites.

Corpus Christi is right in the heart of Cambridge with easy access to many of the historical sights. MPW will have use of the Junior Common Room during the day and the Pelican Room for evenings, where social activities will be organized on one or two evenings each week, subject to interest.

Breakfast (including hot choices) and a two-course buffet evening meal will be served at Corpus Christi (weekdays). Lunch, mid-morning and mid-afternoon refreshments will

be provided at MPW on weekdays. Joining instructions will be sent on registration.

The cost of full-board accommodation at Corpus Christi College is £648 per week excluding VAT (Sunday night to Friday afternoon), payable in full at the time of registration. Students wishing to attend courses for two or three consecutive weeks may stay over the interim weekend(s). An additional £260 excluding VAT is payable for weekend accommodation. Brunch is included on Saturday and Sunday, dinner is not included on Saturday.
