- question-answering techniques and essay-writing skills

- exam board specificity

#### **Tuition**

Our tutors are highly qualified graduates whose experience has trained them to be particularly adept at building students' confidence quickly and efficiently. Many are GCSE or A level examiners and are therefore attuned to the requirements and approaches of the various examination boards.

Group size is limited to an absolute maximum of nine students. Such small classes are essential in order to provide the close attention that each student requires. Students must expect to work hard for the duration of their courses. They are given advice on the best way to revise in the final run-up to their exams.
